

Acianthera javieri Archila, sp nov.


Holotype: Guatemala, Department of Alta Verapaz, Cobán, Tontem Village, collected in the year 2000 at 1400 m above sea level, by Fredy Archila FA-071, (BIGU 37296). (Picture No.1)

Acianthera angustisepala (Ames & Corell) Pridgeon & M.W. Chase similis, labello et sepalis differentibus. *Acianthera angustisepala*, similis labellum et sepa differentibus. Herba pendula caespitose, cum folia viridis et abaxialiter purpurata. Ramicaulis cylindricus, 5,7 cm longus. Inflorescentia racemosa 5 cm longa, basaliter cum bractea. Flos fulvus purpureo maculatus. Sepalum dorsale lineare, cum apicem acuminatum, 1,7 cm longum et 0,2 cm latum. Sepala lateralia saccata, subelliptica cum apicem acuminatum, 1,81 cm longa et 0,81 cm lata. Petala oblongo-elliptica cum marginem dentatum et apicem acuminatum, 0,52 cm longa et 0,13 cm lata. Labellum triangulari-acuminatum, pubescens, 0,66 cm longum et 0,37 cm latum.

Plant epiphytic, cespitose, pendulous. Leaves green, purple beneath, succulent, 12.5 cm long, 3 cm wide, 0.12 cm thick. Ramicauls, 5.7 cm long, cylindrical. Inflorescence with a brown bract at the base, raceme 5 cm long. Flowers pale yellow with purple spots. Dorsal sepal linear, acuminate, 1.7 cm long, 0.2 cm wide. Lateral sepals connate in a synsepal, basally saccate, sub-elliptic, apex acuminate, 1.81 cm long, 0.81 cm. wide. Petals oblong-elliptic, margins serrated from the middle to the apex, acuminate, 0.52 cm long, 0.13 cm wide. Lip triangular, acuminate, basally hastate, densely pubescent at the margins or in the middle, 0.66 cm long, 0.37 cm wide at the base. Column long, oblong, 0.39 cm long with its foot divided in two





parts oblong with rounded apex, 0.23 cm long, 0.06 cm thick. Fruit, dorsally flat, centrally rounded, 1.7 cm long, 0.65 cm wide with the dry portion of the flower forming a horn.

Etymology: Dedicated to my son Javier Archila, important companion on my field trips.

The main differences between *A. javieri* and *A. angustisepala*, are given in table 1.




Fig. 2: *Acianthera javieri* Archila
