Linden, No. 18); foliis acuminatis subtus albidis --- New Grenada, Linden (on the slope of the Peak of Tolima, creeping among mosses and over old stunted trees at 12000' of elevation) h. s. sp.—The flowers are fully 14" long, far larger than in the other species; "yellow, slightly streaked with red," Linden. With their lip and column I am unacquainted.
