At the last meeting of the Horticultural Society in Regent Street this beautiful plant was exhibited by Messrs. Rollissons of Tooting. As it is intended for one of the plates in Mr. Bateman's "Orchidaceæ of Mexico and Guatemala," it is only necessary here to state that it is a plant of a par-

it is only necessary here to state that it is a plant of a particularly graceful habit, and that the flowers are of a clear greenish yellow, with a labellum curiously covered over all the lower part with green warts.
