

C. PACHYRRHIZUM (*Aeranthus pachyrrhizus*, Rchb. f. in *Flora*, 1865, p. 279) is an acaulescent Cuban species, remarkable for its thick fleshy roots, and short racemes of flowers, with distichous bracts. A spathaceus, Griseb (*Cat. Pl. Cub.*, p. 264) is identical. It is also known from Jamaica and Guiana.
