

1. *C. disoides* ; sepalis inferioribus porrectis apice emarginatis attenuatis, labello unguiculato cristato : lobis lateralibus cucullatis membranaceis nudis, intermedio carnosio glanduloso.

Spontè crescit circà *Valparaiso* : Februario florentem legit M^cRae, (v. s. sp.)

Leaves erect, acute, sheathing, as long as the somewhat leafy scape, which rises to the height of six or eight inches. *Squamæ* of the scape membranous, inflated, acute. *Flower* ringent. *Sepals* membranous, veiny, the three upper conniving, erect, lanceolate, somewhat obtuse; the two lower spreading with a tapering, fleshy, channelled, obtuse end. *Labellum* stalked, cordate, cucullate, three-lobed, continuous with the base of the column; the two lateral lobes shorter than the middle one, membranous, veiny, with the anterior margin crenated and callous; the middle lobe ovate, abruptly acuminate, obtuse, fleshy, crested in the middle with numerous fleshy appendages; the disk with seven rows of interrupted excrescences, the lateral rows being shorter than the rest. *Columna* erect, long, linear, with a membranous margin.
