2. Cischweinfia parva (C. Schweinf.) Dressler & Williams, comb. nov. – Miltonia parva C. Schweinf., Am. Orchid Soc. Bull. 14:294, t. 1945.

A few specimens of *C. parva* have been collected in the Chanchamayo Valley, Peru. Garay suggests that it is the same as *C. pusilla* (*Orquideologia* 5:20-21. 1970), but our observations (of the same specimens, at least in part) indicate that they are quite distinct in the features given in the key, though undoubledly closely related. The Colombian plants which Garay cites as *Trichopilia pusilla* may be *C. parva*. As nearly as one can tell from the dried specimens, the sepals and petals are brown and yellow and the lip white or cream.
