

63. *E. stellatum.*

*E. pseudobulbis cepæformibus diphyllis, foliis ensiformibus acutis paniculâ scabrâ longioribus, sepalis petalisque angustioribus lineari-lanceolatis stellatis, labelli lobis lateralibus angustis falcatis intermedio subrotundo plano venis rugulosis, disci callo medio excavato in lineas tres rugulosas procurrente, columnæ auriculis minutis acutis clinandrio denticulato.*

*Wild in the CARACCAS*—Purdie, (*v. s. sp. comm. cel. Hooker.*)

A slender grassy plant, with leaves fifteen inches long by half an inch broad. The stellate flowers and flat round lip are striking peculiarities in the dried state.
