

64. EPIDENDRUM raniferum.

E. foliis distichis lanceolatis obtusis, racemis terminalibus lateralibusque divaricatis multifloris, sepalis ligulatis undulatis apice recurvis petalisque linearibus cuneatis mucronulatis patentissimis, labelli sexlobi basibicallosi laciniis integerrimis: posticis rotundatis—intermediis linearibus—anticis linearibus obtusis retrorsum falcatis.

Hab. in *Mexico*; *Pavon*. (exam. s. sp. in *Herb. Lambert*.)

Caulis crassus, verosimiliter 2-3-pedalis. Folia 7 uncias longa, unam lata. Racemi semipedales. Sepala 10 lineas longa.

This is in Mr. Lambert's Herbarium from Pavon under the names both of *Ophrys tigrina*, and *Epidendrum racemosum*; as I have no means of ascertaining which of these names was intended to be applied by the latter Botanist, I have not hesitated, in this and in other cases, to reject both.
