E. tolimense; caulibus ramosis scaberrimis, foliis ovatolanceolatis, floribus 2-3 terminalibus sessilibus coriaceis, sepalis lineari-lanceolatis acutis striatis, petalis setaceis, labello subcordato ovato concavo apice carnoso basi ecalloso intùs pubescente avenio.——New Grenada.—— This species forms part of Mr. Linden's rich collection. It was found in the forests of Tolima, 10,000 feet above the sea. The flowers are small, and of a dull yellow colour. The branches are excessively rough, with irregular asperities. The leaves are about 1½ inch long.
