

2 bis. E. tolimense; caulibus ramosis scaberrimis, foliis ovato-lanceolatis, floribus 2-3 terminalibus sessilibus coriaceis, sepalis lineari-lanceolatis acutis striatis, petalis setaceis, labello subcordato ovato concavo apice carnosso basi ecalloso intùs pubescente avenio.—*New Grenada*.——
This species forms part of Mr. Linden's rich collection. It was found in the forests of Tolima, 10,000 feet above the sea. The flowers are small, and of a dull yellow colour. The branches are excessively rough, with irregular asperities. The leaves are about $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch long.
