93. N. sanguinea; foliis rectis, labello acuto, columna marginata, clinandrio integerrimo aptero. "An epiphyte, of a bright carmine, and fleshy leaves. On the slope of Tolima, at the height of 6000 feet; February, 1843." (No. 1274). This is a larger plant than N. punctata, and is erect instead of ascending. The leaves are straight, not falcate; the flowers

smaller, and the lip acute, not rounded and dilated.
