





129. *LEPANTHES TRINARIA* Luer & R. Escobar, sp. nov.

Planta parva, inflorescentia racemosa pauciflora folio ovato-cordato brevirostre, sepalis late ovatis acutis, sepalo dorsali sparsim ciliatis, petalis longitabinariis, labelli laminis ellipticis, connectivis latis, appendice pubescenti oblonga apice biloba, connectivis cuneatis, appendice parva ciliata.

TYPE: Colombia: Dept. of Antioquia: epiphytic in cloud forest north of the pass between Urrao and Carmen de Atrato, alt. 2700 m, 12 Dec. 1994, collected by R. Escobar, F. Lopez and W. Teague, flowered in cultivation at Colomborquídeas, 23 May 1995, C. Luer 17530 (Holotype: MO).

broad with a broad body that is connate to the column near the middle. The appendix is oblong and protruding with a bilobed apex.
