Lycaste angelae var. *rubra* Oakeley var. nov. Sect.
Intermediae

A varietate typical floribus rubris differt.

Holotype: San José, Costa Rica, in cultivation, the photo published here, June 2006. Oakeley s.n. (holo. K-HFO). Note: this plant has affinities to *L. x daniloi*.

Description

As for *Lycaste angelae* except the tepals are heavily marked with red.

Etymology

The varietal name *rubra* is Latin for 'red'.
