4. L. cochleata. Lip nearly circular, not spotted; the lateral lobes long, rather acute; the central flat, circular, emarginate, slightly crisp; appendix entire, as large as the lateral lobes. Column long, hairy. Petals hairy.—Native country unknown. Flowers whole-coloured, deep orange; the sepals and petals ovate, the latter obtuse and not much

smaller than the former.
