

MASDEVALLIA Ruiz & Pav.

**M.** (§ Triangulares) **TUBULIFLORA** sp. nov. Aff. *M. floribundæ* Lindl. *Caules* secundarii erecti vel erecto-patuli, 1 cm. longi. *Folium* oblanceolatum, obtusum, rigidum, 5–8 cm. longum, 9–13 mm. latum. *Pedunculus* gracilis, filiformis, folio brevior. *Flores* purpureo-striati?,  $\pm 1$  cm. longi. *Sepalis* usque ad medium coalitis. *Calyx* tubulosus; lobi laterales falcato-lanceolati, 6 mm. longi, 3-nervii; lobus dorsalis carnulosus, linearis, obtusus, 7 mm. longus. *Petala* lineari-lanceolata, uninervia, 4 mm. longa, obtusa, apiculata. *Labellum* lineare, subacutum, ad basim cordatum, lateraliter ad medium bicallosum, 4 mm. longum, 1 mm. latum. *Columna* 3.5 mm. longa.

The petals are dilated at about the middle and provided with a blunt lobule on the anterior margin, 2 mm. from the base. The flowers appear to have been whitish or yellowish when fresh and striped with purple in the throat of the calyx.
