12. EPIDENDRUM tibicinis. Bateman Mss.

"E. tibicinis; caulibus cylindraceis 3-4-phyllis foliis ovatis crassissimis triplo longioribus, scapo altissimo giganteo in racemum multiflorum desinente, floribus ——."

Habitat in Honduras. Skinner.

"By far the most magnificent species of the genus. Flowers of the size and colour of Cattleya labiata, but I have not the means of giving their specific character. Scape three yards long. The hollow cylindrical stems are used as rumpets by the native children: hence the name."
