

***Oreophilus ciliaris* (Luer & Hirtz) Archila
comb. nov.**

Basionym. *Lepanthes ciliaris* Luer & Hirtz,

Synonym. *Brachycladium ciliare* (Luer &
Hirtz) Luer.

Etymology. From the Latin *ciliaris* with *cilia*,
referring to the long ciliate floral parts.
