

***Oreophilus erepsis* (Luer & Hirtz) Archila
comb. nov.**

Basionym. *Lepanthes erepsis* Luer & Hirtz,
Die Orchidee 37: 215, 1986.

Synonym. *Brachycladium erepse* (Luer &
Hirtz) Luer.

Etymology. From the Greek *erepsis* “a roof,”
referring to the broad, concave dorsal sepal.
