

***Oreophilus irrasus* (Luer & R.Escobar)
Archila comb. nov.**

Basionym. *Lepanthes irrasa* Luer & R.Escobar, Monogr. Syst. Bot. Missouri Bot. Gard., 52: 18, 1994.

Synonym. *Brachycladium irrasum* (Luer & R.Escobar) Luer.

Etymology. From the Latin *irrasus* unshaven, referring to the pubescent floral parts.
