

20. *Oreophilus micropetalus* (L.O.Williams)
Archila comb. nov.

Basionym. *Lepanthes micropetala* L.O.Williams, Bot. Mus. Leafl. 9: 4, 1940.

Synonym. *Brachycladum micropetalum* (L.O.Williams) Luer.

Etymology. From the Greek *micropetalon* "small petal," referring to the microscopic petals.

Colombia: Dept., of Cauca, east of el Caramelo, alt. 250–2700 m, collected by E. Valencia. Flowered in cultivation at Colombiorquideas 11 May 1985. C. Luer 11332 (MO). Ecuador: Prov. Carchi Chinchipe, epiphytic in cloud forest between Yangana and Valladolid, alt. 2450 m, 23 Mar 1985, C.Luer, J.Luer, A.Hirtz, & W.Flores 10947 (Holotype); same locality, alt. 2000 m, 18 Mar 1984, C.Luer, S.Dalström, T.Hoijer, D.D'alessandro, & J.Kuit 9626 (MO).
