

29. *Oreophilus platysepalus* (Luer & R.Escobar) Archila comb. nov.

**Basionym.** *Lepanthes platysepala* Luer & R.Escobar, Monogr. Syst. Bot. Missouri Bot. Gard., 52: 36, 1994.

**Synonym.** *Brachycladum platysepalum* (Luer & R.Escobar) Luer.

**Etymology.** from the Greek *platysepalon* a flat sepal in reference to the pubescent leaves.
