

To the species of *Burlingtonia* already mentioned in the Botanical Register under plate 1927, *B. maculata* has been already added in the volume of that work for 1839. I have since received an additional species with the habit of *B. rigida*; it forms no. 664 of Mr. Gardner's collections in the Organ Mountains of Brazil, and differs from that plant in its leaves being smaller, narrower and obtuse, in its flowers being smaller, and in the inflorescence being slightly paniced. These two species may be distinguished by the following characters:

B. rigida (Bot. Reg. sub. t. 1927. Serium Orchid. t. 36.)
 caule erecto ramoso tereti distanter scabellifero, foliis ovato-lanceolatis acutis, racemo simplici nutante, bracteis oblongis acuminatis, labelli bilobi lobis approximatis.

B. obtusifolia; caule erecto ramoso tereti distanter scabellifero, foliis oblongis obtusiusculis, racemo subpaniculato nutante, bracteis subulatis, labelli bilobi lobis distantibus rotundatis.
