

60. **SCAPHYGLÖTTIS** *stellatā* ; (Loddiges in litt.) pseudobulbis fusiformibus, foliis linearibus canaliculatis obtusis emarginatis, fasciculis sessilibus terminalibus, sepalis linearibus secundis patentibus petalis conformibus angustioribus, labello cuneato trilobo lobis lateralibus rotundatis intermedio acutiusculo.

This species nearly resembles *Scaphyglottis violacea*, (Bot. Reg. t. 1901) from which it differs in having larger flowers with spreading segments, and the lateral lobes of the lip as large as the middle lobe. It is a native of Demerara, whence it was obtained by Messrs. Loddiges.
