

119. *Sobralia luteola*, B.S.P. et *S. macroleuca*, Robb. f. *accedit*, n. 2011 et ribes breviter mucronata, lobella subintegra.

Caulis glaber, 1-3 ped. alti. *Petala* oblongo-lanceolata, subcuneata, plerumque 4-7 ped. longa, 1½-1¾ ped. lata. *Flores* in racemos congestos dispositi. *Fructus* subglobosus, indivisus, orate-oblongo, subacuta, glabro, 3-6 lin. longo. *Pericarpium* 1 ped. longi. *Septae* et *pericarpia* oblongo-lanceolata, subacuta, 1½ ped. longa, 4 lin. lata, sepalla lateralibus variata. *Labellosum* fere integrum, oblongum, obtusum v. emarginatum, crispato-crenulatum, 1½ ped. longum, 5 lin. latum, discus 1-nervis, nervis haerentibus. *Columna* clavata, 3 lin. longa, dentibus filiformibus oblongis.

TROPICAL AMERICA.
