

SOBRALIA SUAVEOLENS, *n. sp.*†

This curious novelty may be compared to *Sobralia Bletia*, Rchb. *f.* It has the habit of *Sobralia decora*, Bat., and nice ochroleucous flowers with a wonderful perfume. The lip is white, the keels yellow, brown on the disk of the anterior lacinia of lip. These colours make one think of such *Cælogynes* as *C. lentiginosa*. It was introduced from Colon (Aspinwall) in Central America by Mr. Stanger (once the Orchid grower of late Consul Schiller, now possessor of a good nursery, and member of the directorial committee of our *Gartenbau Gesellschaft*), who presented it to the Botanic Garden, where it flowered in March under M. Donat's care. *H. G. Rchb. f.*
