

70. PLEUROTHÁLLĪS margináta.

P. marginata; folio obovato biconvexo marginulato caule pluries longiore racemo laxo erecto multò breviorè apice obsoletissimè tridentato, sepalis subfalcatis carinatis lateralibus semiconnatis, petalis linearibus obtusis apice callosis, labello lineari obtuso canaliculato.

A very small species with the habit of *P. Grobyi*, and of no beauty. It was sent to Mr. Bateman from Guatemala, by Mr. Skinner, and grows in dense tufts on the branches of trees.
