

13. ***STELIS LONDONNII*** DUQUE, sp. nov.

(PI.V,1-3; PI.XII, 1)

Planta mediocris caespitosa, foliis ellipticis obtusis, caulibus secundariis subaequilongis. Racemo fractiflexo laxe paucifloro, folium plus minusve dupl-citer superante. Floribus parvis. Sepalis similibus, patentibus, viridi-roseis, ovatis obtusis glabris. Petalis oblongibus gracilibus, uninervis. Labello circu-larite oblongo obtusissimo, tribus lobulis, imma basi bigibo, breviter pubes-cente usque citramedium antice excavato. Columna lateribus breviter pubescentibus.

TIPO: Colombia, Antioquia; epífita en monte de Chimiadó, región de Ura-bá alt. ca.1.000 m. Se encontró en el jardín de Rogelio Londoño flore-cida Febrero 28, 1992. O.Duque 1424 (Holotipo:JAUM).

ETIMOLOGIA: se nombró latinizando el nombre, en honor de mi amigo y colega, Rogelio Londoño, mi primer maestro en orquideología.

The name, approximately latinized, in honor of my good friend and collea-gue Rogelio Londoño, my first teacher in orchidology.

Planta mediana cespitosa, epífita, con tallos de 4 cm cubiertos por vainas fibrosas. Hoja elíptica 4.5 x 1 cm, peciolada, obtusa. Inflorescencia un racimo fractiflexo de 12 cm de largo con florecitas amarillo-parduzco de sépalos abiertos, glabros. Órganos centrales amarillos. Pétalos oblon-gos, 1-vena. Labelo lateralmente oblongo, el ápice redondeado, trilobula-do, callo lámina erecta dividida por el glenion, base blanda vellosa.

Plant medium in size, epiphytic, caespitose. Secondary stems erect, apro-ximate, 4 cm long, almost completely covered by 3 fibrous sheaths, unifo- liate. Anulus. **Leaf** erect, elliptic, the lamina 4.5 cm long, 1 cm wide, apex obtuse tridenticulate, narrowing basally into a 1.5 cm long, channeled petiole. **Inflorescence** an erect, strongly fractiflex loosely-flowered, 12 cm long ra-ceme flowering almost to the base of the scape, from a 0.4 cm long spa-the at the base of the leaf. Floral bract at each bend of the scape, broad-ly funnel-shaped, acute, 4.2 cm long. Pedicel 3.5 mm long, ovary 1.5 mm long, both incurved. Flowers medium in size, non resupinate, yellowish-brown with pink streaks outside, central organs yellow, arranged in two rows facing in opposite directions. **Sepals** similar, broadly ovate, obtuse, glabrous, 2 mm long, 3-veined, connated at the base into a small cup. **Petals** thin, laterally oblong, 1-veined, 0.9 high, 1.1 mm wide. **Lip** laterally oblong, suborbicular 3 lobed from above, the face suborbicular, the apex rounded, the base narrow-unguiculate, the disc deeply concave, limi-ted by a transverse lamina cleaved by the wide glenion, butressed be-hind by a semi-spheric mass of shortly villous soft tissue; the lip is 1 mm long and wide. **Column** 1 mm long and wide, the stalk shortly villous, the stigma bilobed.

NOTAS: *S. londoni* se parece, por su racimo fractiflexo, a otras especies de *Stelis*, entre ellas *S. concinna* Lindl., *S. flexuosa* Lindl., *S. wercklei* Schltr. pero difiere de éstas tanto en su hábito como en la forma de los pétalos y el labelo. *S. londoni* parece ser una especie poco común; se distingue fácilmente por el racimo largo, erecto, fractiflexo.

S. londoni resembles, for its fractiflex raceme, other species of *Stelis* such as *S. concinna* Lindl., *S. flexuosa* Lindl., *S. wercklei* Schltr., but it is different from these species by its habit and by the shape of the petals and the lip. *S. londoni* does not seem to be a common species; it may be easily recognized by its long, erect fractiflex raceme.
