Stellilabium minutiflorum (Krzl.) Garay, comb. nov.

Basionym: Telipogon minutiflorus Krzl. in Ann. Nat. Hist. Mus. Wien 33: 14.1919.

Syn.: Telipogon Lankesteri Ames Sched. Orch. 3: 23. 1923. Stellilabium Helleri L. O. Wms. in Brittonia 14: 443. 1962.

This rather rare Costa Rican species has recently been found in the Dominican Republic: by Rev. D. Dod, s.n. (NY). This is also a new record for the West Indies. Stellilabium Helleri L. O. Wms., of which I also have studied the holotype, agrees in every respect with Kraenzlin's type material which I examined in Vienna. Telipogon Lankesteri Ames likewise, does not offer any criterion by which it could be kept separate from S. minutiflorum (Krzl.) Garay.
