

P. arbuscula ; caule erecto ramoso folioso vaginis striatis vestito, foliis ovalibus mucronatis in petiolum brevem angustatis, spicis solitariis secundis foliis duplò longioribus, sepalis linearibus elongatis obtusis, petalis nanis rotundatis, labello lineari obtuso intùs bicarinato.—*Peru.*
——Found near Loxa by Mr. Hartweg. The stems are erect, slightly branched, and covered with firm striated sheaths, from among which appear the leaves, which are about $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch long. The sepals are about half an inch long.
