

192. **P. dura**; folio duro petiolato caule simplici multò breviorè, vaginis costatis, spicis capillaribus elongatis, floribus secundis laxis nutantibus, sepalis rectis liberis carinatis, petalis ligulatis columnæ longitudine basi angustioribus, labello ligulato sulcato velutino canaliculato supra basim obtusangulo—
Peru, Jameson (Forests of the Andes), h. s. sp.—Very like the last, but the stem is not proliferous. Flowers (yellow?) whole coloured, larger. (Column with a three-lobed hood, of which the side divisions are somewhat falcate and blunt, and much larger than the dorsal which is spoon-shaped.)
