3. Pogonia Wagneri (Schltr.) L. Wms., comb. nov. Triphora Wagneri Schltr. in Fedde Rep. Sp. Nov. 17:139. 1921.

Small, leafless, erect, terrestrial herbs up to 7.5 cm. tall. Inflorescence 1-flowered, the flower erect. Dorsal sepal about 12 mm. long, ligulate, obtuse. Lateral sepals about 12 mm. long, ligulate, obtuse, falcate. Petals a little shorter and a little broader than the dorsal sepal, ligulate, obtuse, subfalcate-oblique. Lip about 10 mm. long and 5 mm. broad, narrowly obovate-cuneate in outline, prominently 3-lobed near the apex; lateral lobes obliquely ovate, obtuse; mid-lobe semiovate, obtuse, somewhat undulate; disc with 3 thickened, subversucose nerves toward the apex.

Known only from Panama.

CHIRIQUÍ and VERAGUAS: Wagner 1778.

The description is taken from the original and a manuscript analysis.
